SUCCESS AFTER SCHOOL 2020-2021

REGISTRATION:

Registration packet, registration fee, and weekly fee are required **24 hours** prior to the child starting the after school program. The weekly fee is due Friday by 6:00pm prior to next week care beginning. A **\$20.00** late fee will be applied to payments made after 6:00pm on Friday. Non-payment prior to care may result in a disruption of child care services. Financial assistance is available to those that qualify. TRANSPORTATION: SUBJECT TO ENROLLMENT

Transportation is available but limited from the following schools to the Lakeland Family YMCA:

Cleveland Court Elementary, Dixieland Elementary, Highlands Grove Elementary, Lakeland Highlands Middle, Lincoln Avenue Academy, Phillip O'Brien Elementary, Magnolia Montessori, Medulla Elementary, R. Bruce Wagner Elementary, Rochelle School of Arts, Scott Lake Elementary, Sikes Elementary, South McKeel Elementary, and Southwest Elementary. Children are escorted over by YMCA staff from Carlton Palmore.

*Children grades VPK-5th may be dropped off between the hours of 3:00pm - 6:00pm. Parent/Guardian must provide transportation.
