



YMCA Campus eSchool Program

We are pleased to offer the YMCA Campus eSchool Program, designed to support the online education and instruction your child will receive from school this fall.

Our program was created with an intentional whole-student approach that includes:

- On-site education support. Students bring their own assignments, materials, and technology (cell phones prohibited). WiFi and in-person academic support is provided by the Y. **Please provide noise-canceling headphones for your child.**
- Peer connection and social-emotional development through social-emotional learning (SEL) activities.
- Choice of Y Enrichment: Art, STEM, Music & Movement, Sports & Physical Fitness, Swim Lessons (through our afternoon extension program), Dramatic & Construction Play, Science Exploration, and MORE.

Safety guidelines are put in place including the following:

- Strict safety and cleaning protocols based on guidelines from the CDC and Department of Health. Routine cleaning, sanitizing/disinfecting practices will be intensified, paying extra attention to frequently touched objects and surfaces.
- Limited enrollment at each YMCA facility. 1:10 staff-to-student ratio.
- Social distancing and masks for students and staff when indoors (and when social distancing is not possible outdoors).
- We plan to keep the same groups of children and counselors together throughout the day and from day-to-day to the greatest extent possible.
- Each morning, you will be asked to fill out a brief Health Survey for your child at drop-off.

YMCA Campus eSchool Program: Fall 2020

REGISTRATION:

Registration packet, registration fee, and weekly fee are required **24 hours** prior to the child starting the after school program. The weekly fee is due Friday by 6:00pm prior to next week care beginning. A **\$10.00** late fee will be applied to payments made after 6:00pm on Monday. Non-payment prior to care may result in a disruption of child care services. Financial assistance is available to those that qualify. Weekly Rate: \$120, second child discount \$5 off

Hours: Monday-Friday, 7am-6pm

Ages: 5-12 (must be enrolled in Kindergarten)



Please Note: Students must be checked-in prior to 7:45am to begin their lessons each day. YMCA eSchool will run from 8am-2:30pm. Success Afterschool (extended hours) will run from 2:30pm-6:30pm.
